WHO IS THE DEVIL?

The Devil was called Lucifer (meaning Bearer of Light) and Son Of The Morning when he was an archangel in heaven. He became prideful and rebelled against God in the spirit world and was cast out along with one third of the angels (those that he had convinced to follow him). He is now known as Satan and the "prince of the power of the air." He is neither in Heaven nor in Hell but on the earth. The Bible warns us that not only does he "prowl about like a roaring lion," but also that he is "the god of this world, the prince and power of the air." He, in his invisible form, is active in deceiving, perverting, and corrupting all that is good and right in the world. He will eventually be destroyed, thrown into the lake of fire at the final judgment.
